The Areas

Our lodge; **Zulu Wings Game Lodge**; is run purely for our wing shooting safaris. We are situated in the farming district of Dundee, Northern KwaZulu Natal. This is a grain-growing area & consequently we have an excellent variety of game birds & waterfowl.

Ducks, Geese, Dove, Pigeon, Guineafowl & Francolin are all shot during each safari & within close distance to the Lodge. This is not a hot barrel hunt, but good steady shootings the order of the day. This combined with the variety makes this an excellent safari.

Baynesfield is close to Durban and has to be one of the most picturesque areas in South Africa to shoot birds in. We have 4 cabins here overlooking a trout lake on a 25 000 acre Estate. Baynesfield is our main goose shooting area. Along with Geese the area also has excellent Red eyed doves (Doves the size of pigeons), Red Necked Spurfowl and Duck.

In 2006 we included specialized pigeon shoots in **Bloemfontein**. This is one of South Africa's main Sunflower growing areas and the Pigeons are found here in their thousands. Mostly; they offer highly challenging past shooting. Our most common package includes all these areas with a break in the middle at a 5 Star Game Reserve.

GENERAL INFORMATION

If you would like to experience the best Southern Africa has to offer, then a combination of South Africa, Botswana and Mozambique cannot be beat.

Waterfowl Collector Hunts

South Africa is blessed with a great variety of Waterfowl. On a normal 7-Day Collector's hunt, the hunter can expect to collect between 10 and 13 species. If he adds Mozambique to the trip a further 3 species can be added, including the highly sort after Pygmy Goose.

The best time for this trip to South Africa is late August; for Mozambique, it's early September as this ensures pristine plumage.

6. Pre-Clearances for guns in South Africa as well as Pre-Clearances for Semi Automatic shotguns.
6. Gun licenses for Mozambique and Botswana
7. Hunting licenses for Botswana and Mozambique
